
SIX DAYS OF SUN

ROADKILL ROCK, CALIFORNIA, 2030: Hope Morgan's life gets flipped on it's head when her mother is diagnosed with a fatal disease. From the first consultation, it's clear: her mother will not only be the most important patient she cares for -but also the most difficult.



After failing to save her mother, Hope turns her attention to a young boy suffering from the same disease. With redemption at her fingertips, Hope sets out to cure the child by any means necessary.



AMERICA: 2030

As climate change became an even more urgent issue, Americans finally became fed up with the lack of governmental action. This anger led to marches, riots, and eventually, a total discharge of every decision-maker in government, leaving the people fully in power of their new e-democracy.

Soon after, the American people voted on their first initiative, Project Sunblock, which that did just that -blocked the Sun from Earth. For twenty four hours a day, six days a week, the world was in darkness.
